Project Limits



Red box represents the approximate project limits of the slope repair area.






Project Overview

Project's purpose and need

- The purpose of the project is to repair the roadway embankment on the west side of WIS 16
- The existing roadway embankment has been undermined and is being eroded.
- Not repairing the embankment could jeopardize the WIS 16 pavement structure





Project Overview Traffic Control

- WIS 16 southbound lane will be closed to traffic
 - This is to provide space for contractor to work and access the slope
- Temporary Signals will be used to provide access on the existing northbound lane





Next Steps

- Real estate is anticipated to begin in Fall 2025
 - 1 parcel requires a Temporary Limited Easement (TLE)
- Final plans are due in May 2026*
- Project awarded in August 2026*


