WIS 19, Division Street to River Road Dane County

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing improvements to WIS 19 near the village of Waunakee in Dane County to address aging and deteriorated pavement as well as intersection operational improvements.

Please join us for a public involvement meeting to discuss this scheduled rehabilitation and resurfacing project. The meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday**, **May 3**, **2022**, **from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.** at the Waunakee Public Library, 201 N Madison Street, Waunakee, WI 53597. A brief presentation will start at 5:00 pm and the remainder of the meeting will follow an open house format.

Improvements from Division Street to Schumacher/Raemisch Road includes a roadway reconstruction with added turn lanes, signal upgrades, curb ramps updates, and a raised median. From Schumacher/Raemisch Road to River Road improvements will consist of a mill and overlay and select culvert replacements. A project location map is attached for your use.

WIS 19 will remain open during construction. The proposed work between Division Street and Schumacher/Raemisch Road will be performed under construction staging and the remainder of the project will be performed with lane closures using flaggers.

The project will need to purchase right of way and temporary easements for the proposed improvements. Real estate staff will be available at the meeting if there are any questions. The real estate process will begin in Fall 2023. Construction is scheduled to occur in 2026.
