

Project Location








Purpose and Need

- Safety
 - Schumacher/Raemisch Road left turn crashes



- Operations
 - Division Street and Hogan Road intersections do not meet the needs of forecasted traffic volumes
















Purpose and Need

- Roadway Condition
 - Existing pavement has reached the end of its useful life
 - Existing curb ramps do not meet standards
- Drainage
 - Culverts in poor condition
 - Stormwater management needs at Six Mile Creek structure










Proposed Improvements Division Street to Schumacher Road


- Pavement improvements
 - Full-depth reconstruction
 - 14-foot raised median















Proposed Improvements Division Street to Schumacher Road

Intersection Improvements

Division Street Intersection

- New traffic signals
- Improved pedestrian facilities
- Dedicated turn lanes on WIS 19
- New storm sewer

















Proposed Improvements Division Street to Schumacher Road

Intersection Improvements

Schumacher/Raemisch Road Intersection

- New traffic signals
- Offset left-turn lanes on WIS 19
- New culvert




















Proposed Improvements Six Mile Creek Bridge

- Repaint the bridge rail on the bridge structure
- Remove inlets on bridge structure and outlet north of WIS 19





















Proposed Improvements Hogan Road

- Intersection Improvements
 - Raised medians
 - Channelized offset left turn lanes
 - Dedicated turn lanes on Hogan Road
 - New storm sewer
- Traffic signals
 - Signal warrant will be conducted summer of 2025




















Proposed Improvements Schumacher Road to River Road

- Pavement improvements
 - Mill existing pavement and overlay with new pavement
 - Reshape aggregate shoulders







Proposed Improvements Schumacher Road to River Road

- Drainage improvements
 - Replace culverts in poor condition

- Safety improvements
 - Enhanced friction surface treatment for horizontal s-curve
 - Replacing shoulder and centerline rumble strips





Traffic Control 2026 Construction

- Keep WIS 19 open to traffic
 - Staged construction between Division and Schumacher Road
 - Flagging operations from Schumacher Road to River Road
 - Nighttime closures are required for culvert replacements
- Maintain access to residences and businesses
- Minimize side road closures
- Maintain bicycle and pedestrian access at Division Street
 - At least one north-south crossing of WIS 19 will be provided at all times.











Traffic Control – Stage 1 Division Street to Schumacher Road

Shift traffic north, construct eastbound WIS 19 lanes
























Traffic Control – Stage 2 Division Street to Schumacher Road

Shift traffic south, construct westbound WIS 19 lanes



























Traffic Control – Stage 3 Division Street to Schumacher Road

Split traffic to outside shoulders, construct raised median

























Traffic Control Hogan Road

Construct turn lanes and side roads in stages

Traffic Control Schumacher Road to River Road

- Mill and overlay work will be done with a one-way flagging operation during offpeak traffic times
- Two nighttime closures required for culvert replacements



- Construction Begins Spring 2026









