Purpose of the meeting

The objective of this meeting is to obtain your input on the identified needs and proposed improvements of WIS 19.

The public involvement meeting will begin with a brief PowerPoint presentation outlining the project's history, the purpose and need, and the anticipated project timeline. Following the presentation, representatives from WisDOT along with the project engineer will be available throughout the room to answer questions, discuss project details, and gather input from attendees in an informal, open-house style setting

Project information

WisDOT is proposing to improve 4.3 miles of WIS 19 from the Mauneshia River Bridge in the village of Marshall to Palmer Street in the city of Waterloo.

The purpose of this project is to address pavement deterioration, structural maintenance needs, pedestrian accessibility deficiencies, and roadside safety device performance within the project limits.

Proposed improvements include:

- Resurface the pavement along WIS 19 with a mill and overlay
- Perform structural repairs on two existing bridges on the east side of the village of Marshall
- Update curb ramps to current standards
- Repair or replace existing beam guard as necessary

The environmental document for this project is currently under development by the project team. The environmental document is expected to be completed by May 2026.

Proposed traffic impacts

Construction for this project is anticipated to occur during the summer and/or fall of 2029. Traffic is anticipated to be maintained under flagging operations while construction is occurring. Single lane closures on WIS 19 for the structure repair work on the east side of the village of Marshall will require temporary signals, which will require a closure of the Box Elder Road and WIS 19 intersection while the structure repairs are occurring. Access will be maintained to properties located along the corridor during construction. Emergency vehicle accessibility will also be maintained throughout the project.

Real estate

Additional right of way and temporary easements will be required for this project. The curb ramp upgrades will require minor right of way acquisitions within the Village of Marshall. The WisDOT Southwest Region real estate section will be reaching out to the impacted parcels to begin the real estate acquisition process within the next year. Preliminary right of way impacts are shown on the exhibits.
