## WIS 69: 2026 Construction

Welcome to the public involvement meeting for the proposed improvements to WIS 69. See Figure on the next page for the project location.

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the process of finalizing project plans for construction on WIS 69. The objective of this meeting is to provide you with updated information regarding the proposed improvements and construction schedule.

Improvements include, but are not limited to:

- Mill and overlay from Bushnell Creek to Cow Path Lane
- Constructing a roundabout at the County C intersection
- Adding left turn lanes at the Wittenwyler Road and Cemetery Road intersections
- Culvert replacements
- Rehabilitation of bridge over West Branch Little Sugar River

Construction is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2026. During construction, project work will be split into three stages:

### Stage 1 and Stage 2 traffic:

- Motorists can expect flagging throughout the project limits and lane shifts near County C.
- County C and Urban Road will be closed to traffic.
- The expected duration is three months.

### Stage 3 traffic:

- WIS 69 will have hard closures for culvert replacements, for roundabout work at County C/Urban Rd, and for bridge work near County F (Lake Avenue).
- A seven-week detour will be posted on the following route: WIS 11 to WIS 81 to WIS 78 to WIS 39.
  - Closure timeline between July 13th, 2026 and August 28th, 2026
    - Subject to change due to delays
- Access to business and homes will be maintained, however, the route to access them will be modified depending on the location of culvert work.
- County F (Lake Avenue), County C, and Urban Rd will be closed to traffic.

### Stage 4 traffic:

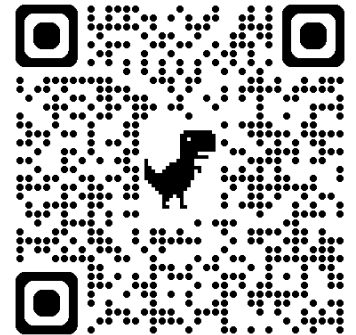
- Motorists can expect flagging.

- The expected duration is one month.
