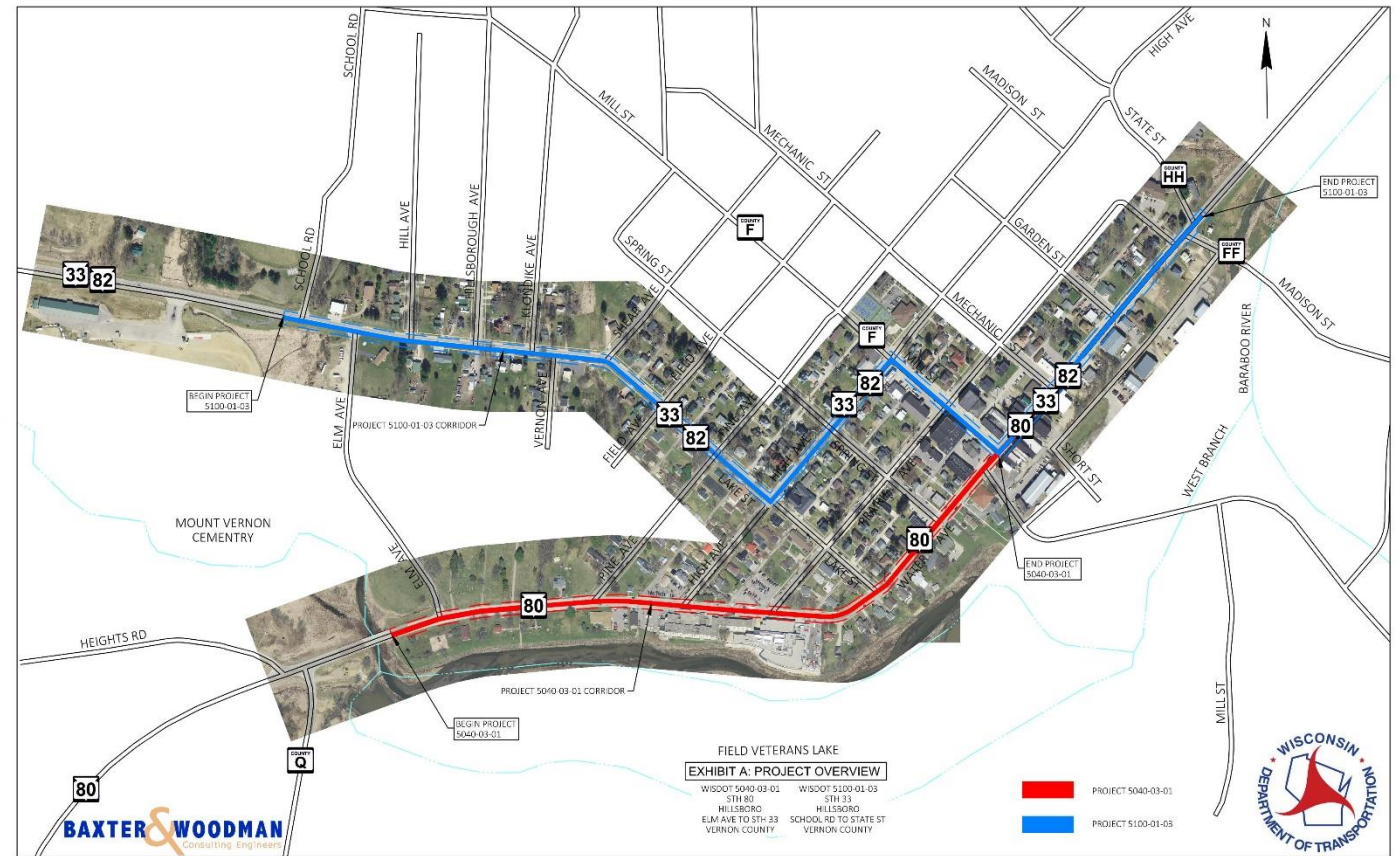

- Replace the pavement of WIS 80 and WIS 33

- Need

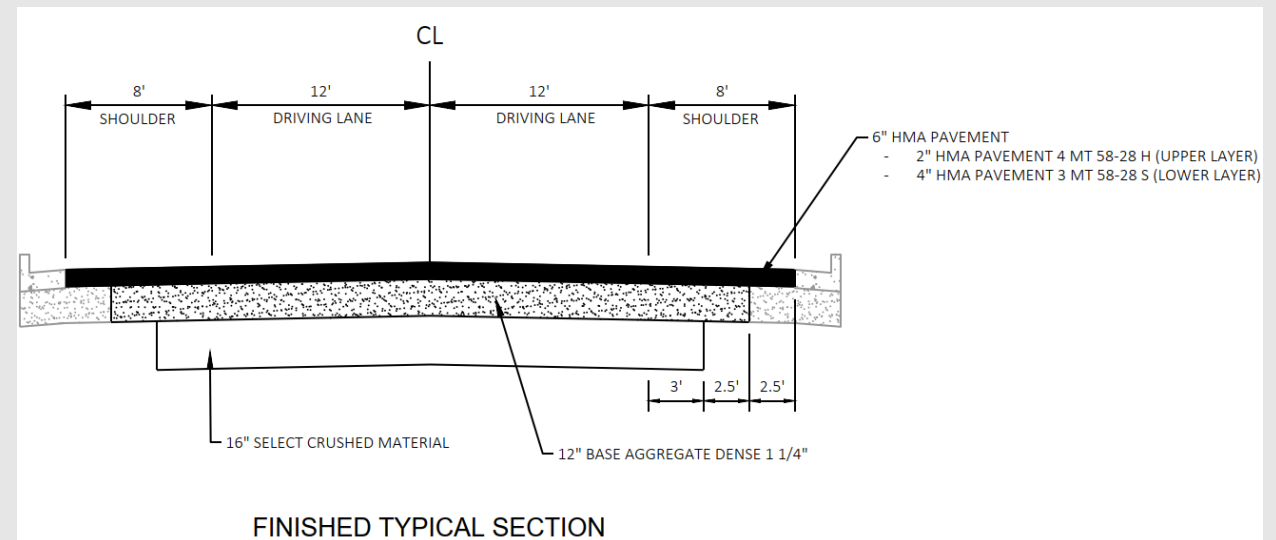
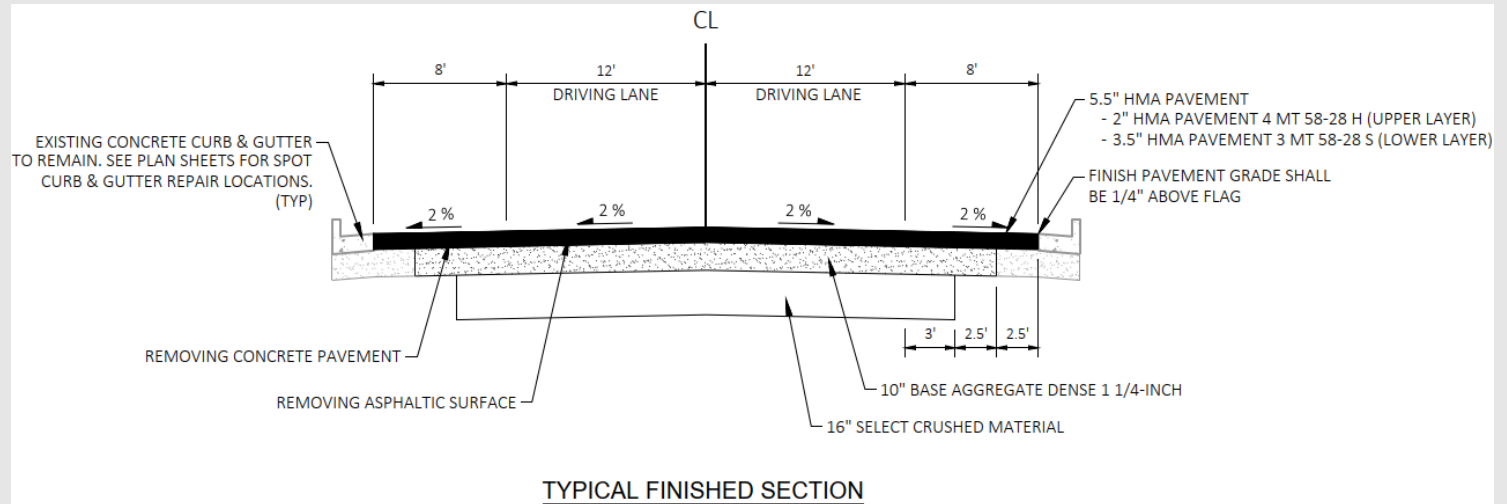
- The existing pavement has extensive alligator cracking, edge cracking, longitudinal and transverse cracking.



Proposed Improvements

- Pavement

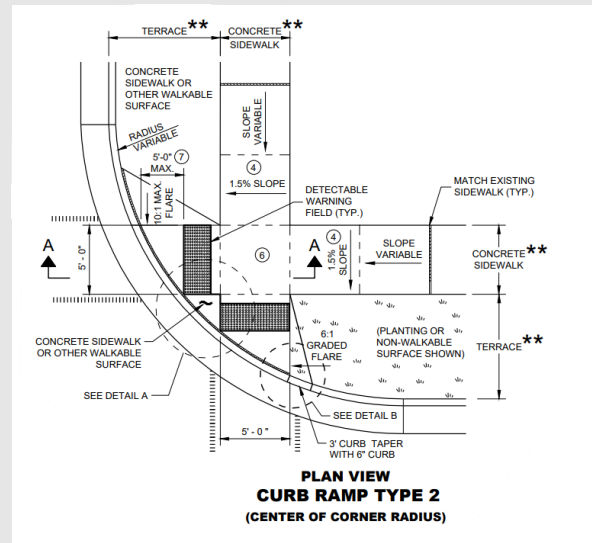
- Remove of existing asphalt pavement
- Place 16" of Select Crushed Material, 10-12" of base aggregate, and 5.5" – 6" of new asphalt pavement



Proposed Improvements

- Curb Ramps

- To be replaced to meeting current ADA standards
- Curb extensions/bump outs at select locations for compliance



Proposed Improvements

- City Water and Sewer Updates



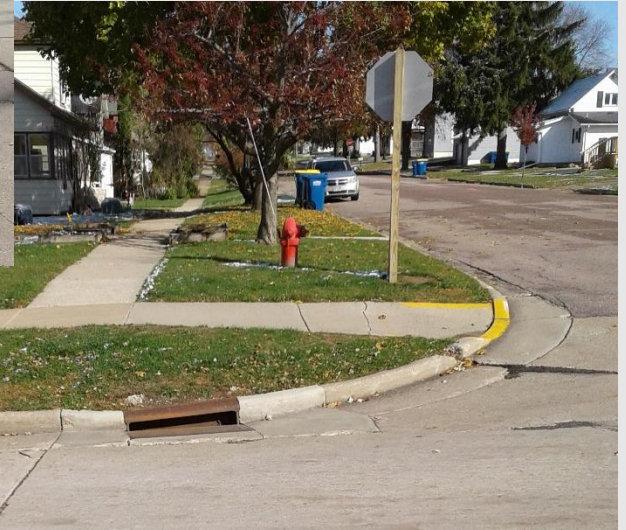
Real Estate

- TLE

- Temporary Limited Easements will be required for curb ramp work

- Right-of-Way Acquisitions

- Right-of-way acquisitions will be required for curb ramp work



Encroachments/Access

- Encroachments

- Any object within the highway right-of-way being reviewed
- May require removal or revocable occupancy permit

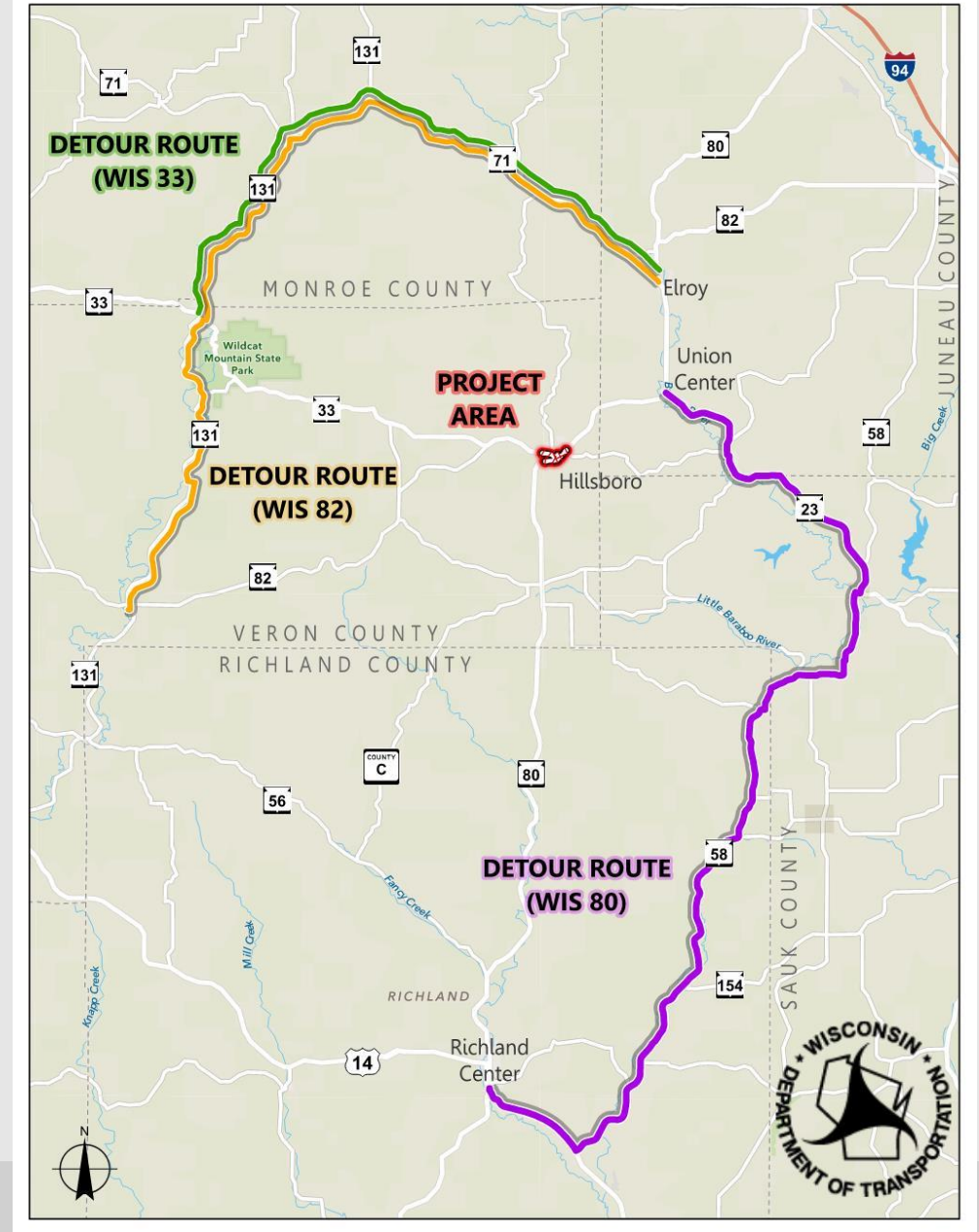
- Access

- All driveways reviewed for compliance with policy/statutes
- Letters sent to impacted properties outlining review/appeal process

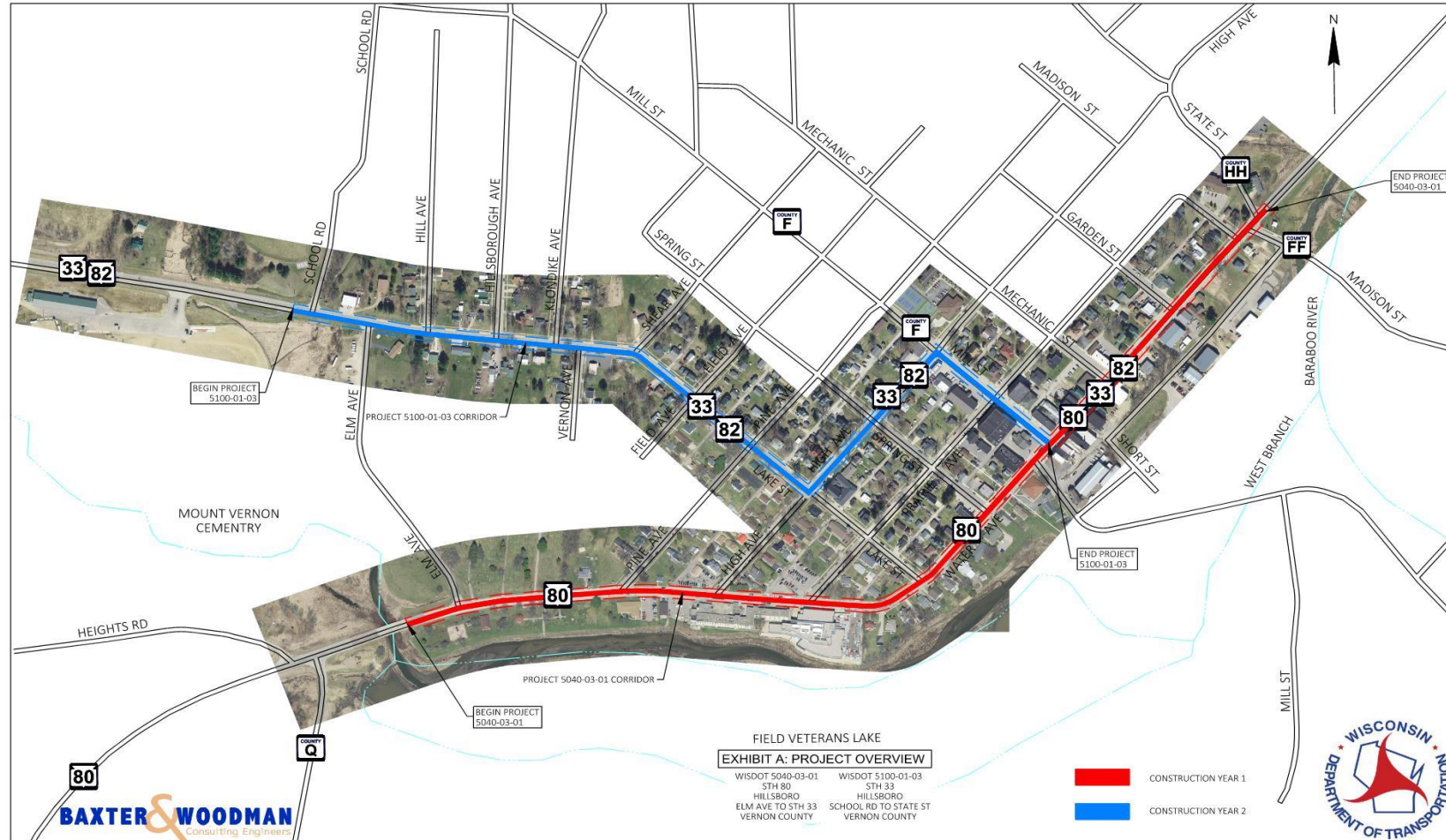


Traffic Impacts

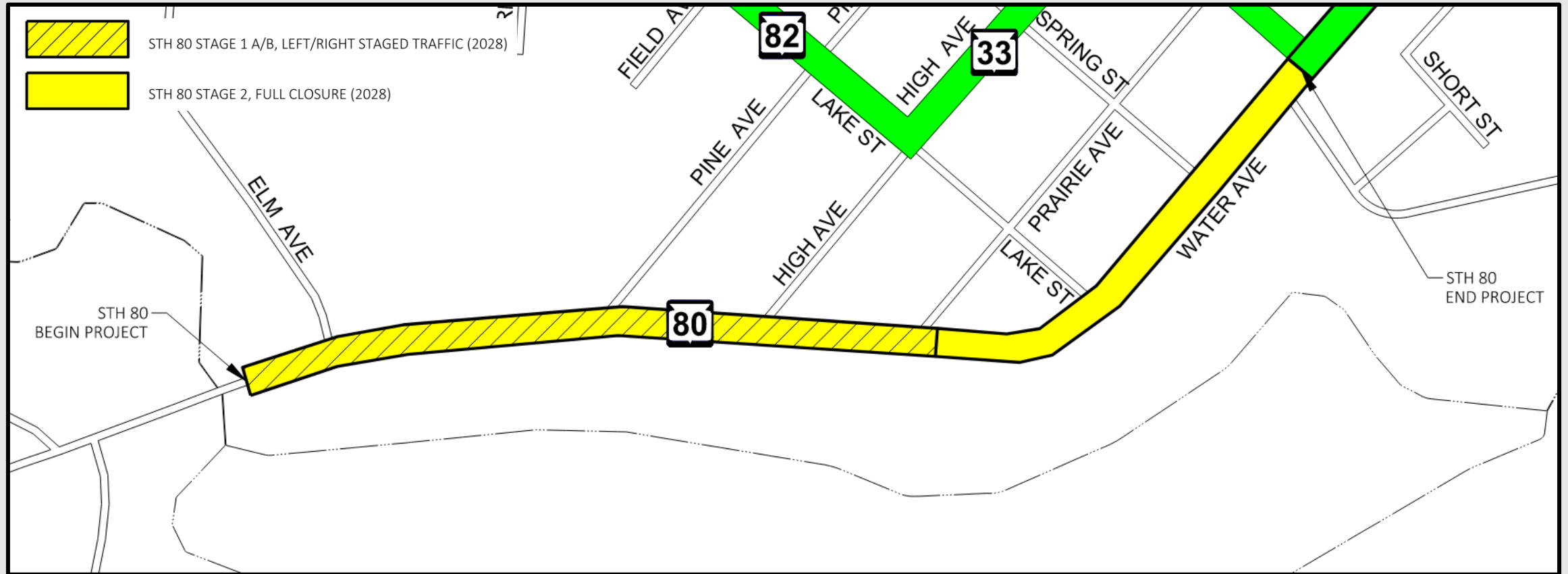
- Detour
 - Full road closure
 - Access to properties maintained
 - WIS 33 & 82 detour route via WIS 131 & 71
 - WIS 80 detour route via WIS 58 & 23
- Phasing
 - Project to be phase to minimize local traffic disruption

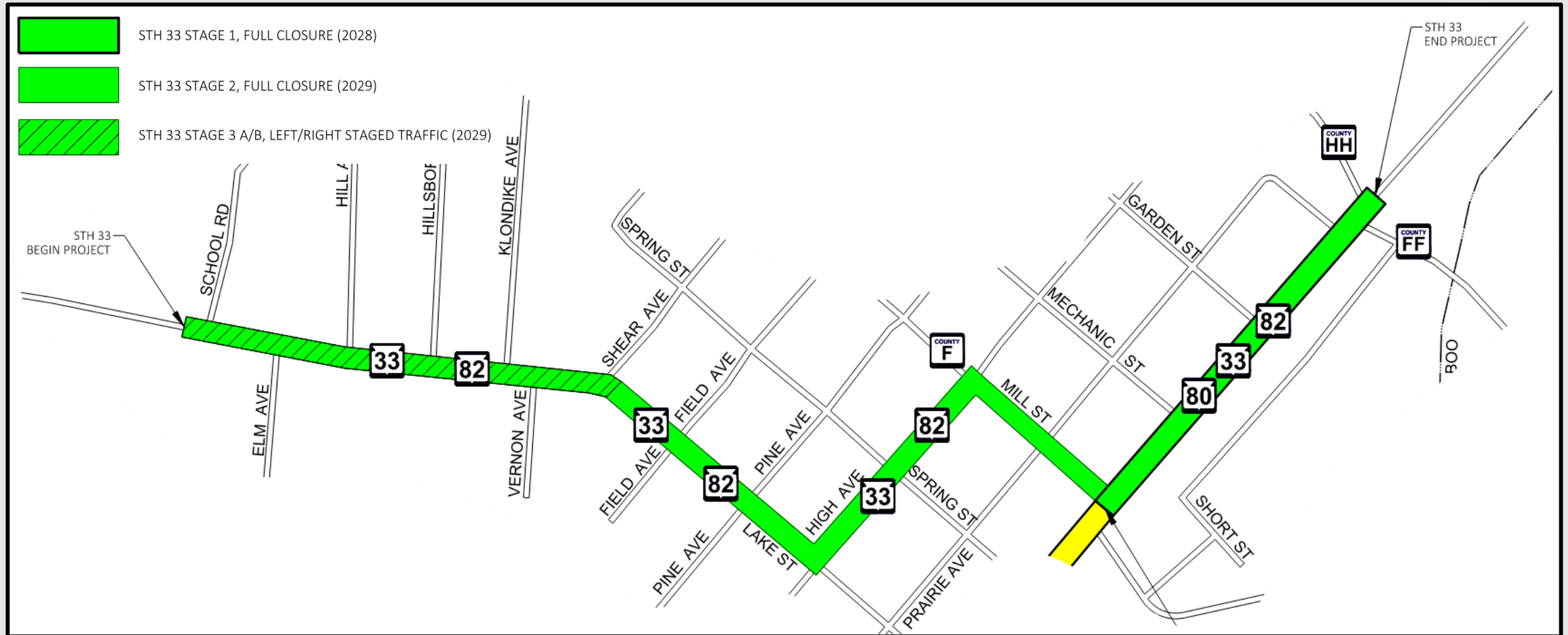


STH 80 STAGE 1 A/B, LEFT/RIGHT STAGED TRAFFIC (2028)

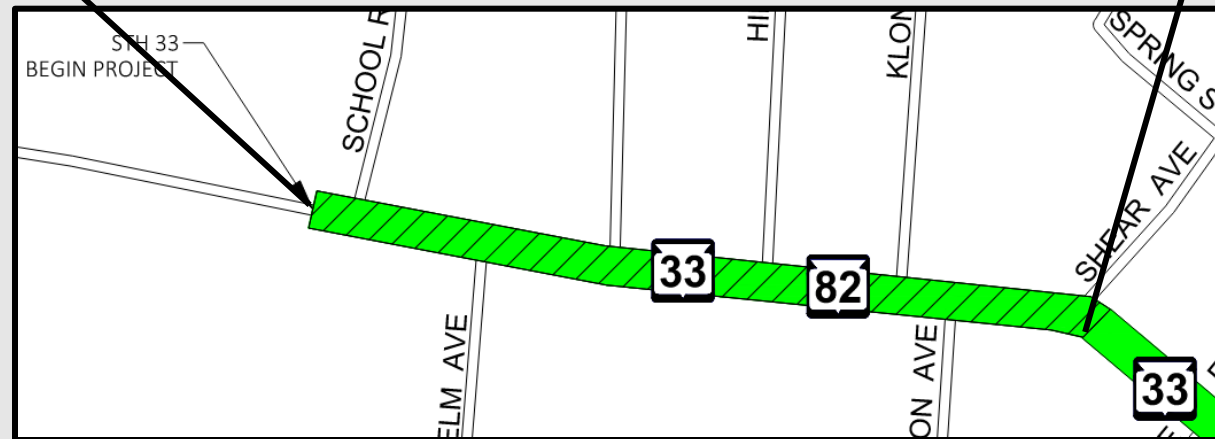
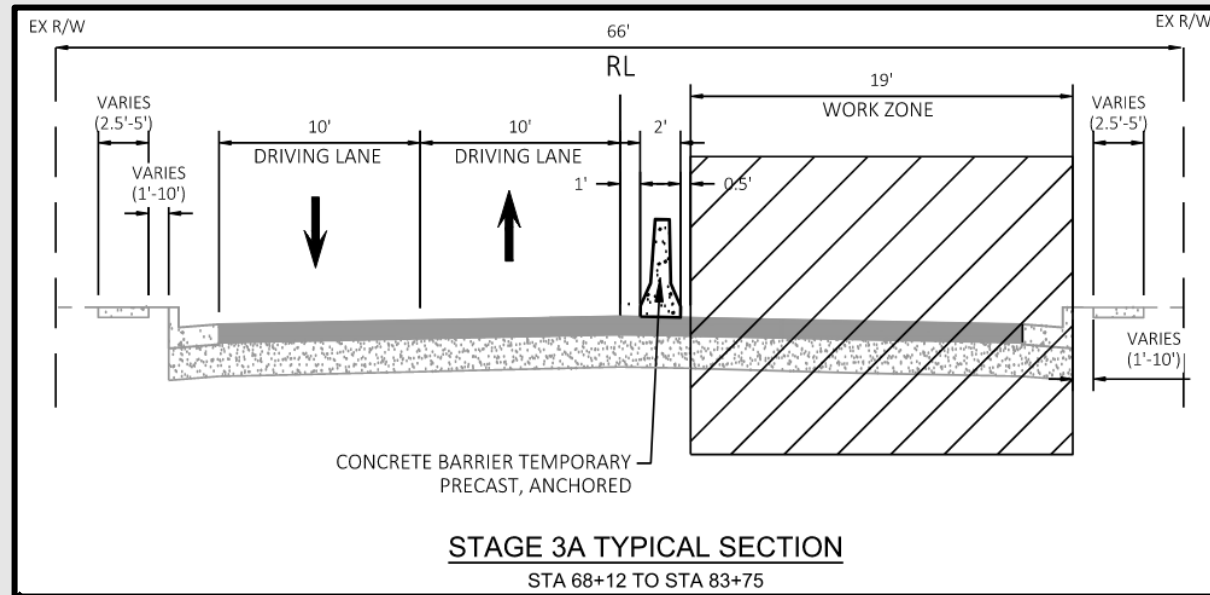
