#### Purpose of the meeting


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the process of developing plans for proposed improvements on 0.89 miles of WIS 89 (E Madison Street) in the City of Waterloo in Jefferson County. The purpose of this handout is to provide information regarding the proposed improvements, describe the potential impacts it would have on the community, and offer an opportunity for public comment.

### **Public input**

Your comments assist us in developing a project that will serve the needs of the traveling public as well as the needs of the local community and are welcomed and appreciated throughout the design process. #### **Project location**

WIS 89 (E Madison Street) from the Waterloo East Limit to the Maunesha River Bridge in the City of Waterloo in Jefferson County.



#### Project purpose and need

The purpose of the project is to address the deteriorated roadway that is exhibiting cracking and rutting. The project will include a pavement replacement of the entire pavement structure including the underlying base aggregate materials. The project will also include the replacement of storm sewer, sidewalk, curb ramps, and street lighting. Sanitary sewer and water main will be replaced by the City of Waterloo prior to the project.

#### **Proposed improvements**

This is a pavement replacement level project. Proposed improvements include:

- Pavement replacement
- Curb and gutter replacement
- Sidewalk replacement
- Curb ramp upgrades
- Street lighting replacement
- Storm sewer replacement
- Sanitary sewer replacement (City of Waterloo to replace prior to project)
- Water main replacement (City of Waterloo to replace prior to project)

#### **Anticipated benefits**

The project will provide motorists with a smoother riding surface resulting in less wear on vehicles, decrease maintenance costs, and improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians with new sidewalk and ADA compliant curb ramps.

## Traffic impacts

WIS 89 (E Madison Street) will be closed to through traffic during construction. A detour is tentatively proposed to utilize WIS 19, WIS 73, and I-94. A detour for WIS 19 is tentatively proposed to utilize WIS 73, I-94, and WIS 26. Access to adjacent properties and for emergency responders will be maintained. Pedestrian access will be provided during construction by constructing sidewalk on one side at a time and with the use of temporary pedestrian accommodations.

#### **Schedule**

Public Involvement: Summer 2025
Environmental Document: Fall 2025
Preliminary Design: 2025 to 2026

Real Estate: 2026 to 2027Final Design: 2026 to 2027

Construction: 2028

#### Real estate

Fee right-of-way acquisition will be required at spot locations for sidewalk and curb ramps. Temporary limited easements will be required for grading behind sidewalk and matching existing driveways. A real estate consultant will contact affected property owners in the future regarding acquisitions.
