
Project Summary

- Located along WIS 89 (E Madison Street) from the Waterloo East Limit to the Maunesha River Bridge in the City of Waterloo, Jefferson County
- WisDOT Project ID:
 - **Design:** 3290-00-05
 - Construction: 3290-00-75
- Project Length: 0.89 Miles

Project Purpose and Need

- The purpose of the project is to address the deteriorated roadway that is exhibiting cracking and rutting.
- Storm sewer and local utilities will be replaced.
 - Sanitary sewer and water main will be replaced by the City of Waterloo prior to the project





- Replacement of the following items:
 - Pavement and base aggregate
 - Curb and gutter
 - Sidewalk and curb ramps
 - Street lighting
 - Storm sewer
 - Sanitary sewer (replaced by City of Waterloo prior to project)
 - Water main (replaced by City of Waterloo prior to project)














- West Project Limit Mill Street
 - Replace existing cross section in kind


















- Mill Street Hickory Lane
 - Replace existing cross section in kind


















- Hickory Lane Fischer Road
 - Replace existing cross section in kind


















- Fischer Road East Project Limit

Traffic Impacts

- WIS 89 and WIS 19 will be closed to through traffic during construction
- WIS 89 detour tentatively proposed to utilize WIS 19, WIS 73, and I-94
- WIS 19 detour tentatively proposed to utilize WIS 73, I-94, and WIS 26





Traffic Impacts

- Access to adjacent properties and for emergency responders will be maintained
- Pedestrian access to be maintained by staged construction and temporary accommodations





Real Estate

- Fee right-of-way acquisition will be required at spot locations for sidewalk and curb ramps.
- Temporary limited easements will be required for grading behind sidewalk and matching existing driveways.





Schedule

- Public Involvement: Summer 2025
- Environmental Document: Fall 2025
- Preliminary Design: 2025 to 2026
- Real Estate: 2026 to 2027
- Final Design: 2026 to 2027
- Construction: 2028


