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**Background:** TR309.24(1)(k) requires every ambulance to be equipped with impervious, radiolucent long backboard and short extrication/ immobilization device. Long back-board shall be head-to-feet length with at least 3 appropriate restraint straps and with capabilities to add padding for children and handholds for moving patients.

**Variance Request:** A variance request was submitted to the Division of State Patrol (DSP) by the Systems Management & Development Committee of the Wisconsin EMS board to not require ambulances to be equipped with a <a href="mailto:short">short</a> extrication/immobilization device (KED board, half board, short board). These types of devices are not included in the WI. Dept. of Health Services (DHS) guidance, including the EMS Standard of Care & WI. EMS Protocols. This variance does not conflict with DHS scope of practice.

**Guidance:** The Division of State Patrol in agreement with the Division of Public Health, approve this variance with the following requirement:

- Each ambulance shall still carry an *impervious*, *radiolucent long backboard* that is head-to-feet length with at least 3 appropriate restraint straps and with capabilities to add padding for children and handholds for moving patients.
- Trans 309.07(5) requires a copy of the variance to be carried in the ambulance at all times.
