



RULES OF THE ROAD AND SAFETY

It is unlawful for any person to drive in a reckless manner or at such speed as to endanger the lives or property of others. Be reasonable and drive carefully. Stop at all stop signs or signals.

Approach railroad crossings cautiously.

Fifteen miles per hour while passing schoolhouses at times when children are going to or from school or are playing at or about the school. Pass school children upon the highway with due care and caution.

Do NOT overtake and pass another vehicle on the

dren upon the highway with due care and caution.

Do NOT overtake and pass another vehicle on the crest of a grade, on a curve, at railroad or highway intersections, or where the operator's view is obstructed within a distance of three city blocks.

When overtaking another car, pass to the left, but do so only where the left side is clearly visible and free from oncoming vehicles for a sufficient distance to permit such passing in safety.

The law requires the dimming, depressing, or tiling of the front headlights so that the rays projected will not blind the person whom such driver is approaching and about to pass.

The law requires the reporting to the Wisconsin Highway Commission of all accidents involving personal injury or death or property damage totaling \$50 or more, within 48 hours.

Parking is prohibited on the main traveled portion of highways; also near the crest of hills or on curves and turns.

Except when passing, keep to right side of road, especially on curves and hills. Except when passing, keep to right side of road, especially on curves and hills.

Make sure your vehicle is mechanically safe to drive. Check the brakes, tires, and safety devices, such as rear view mirror, etc.

Use hand signals to tell the driver behind what you are going to do. He is not a mind reader.

RESTRICTIONS ON HEAVY VEHICLES

No vehicle or combination of vehicles, except busses, having a gross weight of more than ten thousand pounds shall be operated at a speed greater than thirty-five miles per hour.

The speed limits for motor busses shall be the same as the speeds permitted passenger vehicles.

Every motor vehicle having a width at any part in excess of eighty inches shall carry two clearance signal lights on the left side of such vehicle, one located at the front and the other located at the rear of the vehicle. Such lights shall show a green, blue or amber light to the front and a red light to the rear.

Flare lights must be placed approximately one hundred twenty-five feet to the front and rear of vehicles stopping on the traveled way at night.

Restrictions as to size and gross weights of heavy vehicles are as follows:
