- Communicate with your Bike Buddy to agree on a meeting point, schedule, and route
 - · Consider meeting at a Park and Ride lot, retail parking lot, or shared use path
 - Be punctual and arrive with your gear and equipment ready to ride
- Discuss your experience level including the following questions...
 - What pace are you comfortable with?
 - What should you do if you are separated by traffic or at a signal?
- Follow predictable riding habits ride straight, maintain a relatively constant speed, and keep at least one bike distance between you and your buddy
- Warn each other of hazards in the roadway or bike lane
