

My 511WI notifications for Merrimac Ferry

Follow these steps to stay informed on when the Merrimac Ferry will be closed for repairs or maintenance work.

1. Visit 511wi.gov and click on “My 511WI” at the top of the page.
2. Select “Register” in the drop-down menu and enter the required information.
 - a. Enter your mobile phone number to receive text alerts. Text messages do not provide closure timeframes. Click “register” when complete.
3. A confirmation email was sent to your inbox. Check your spam folders if you don't see the confirmation email in your inbox. Click the link in that email and log in.
4. Click “create new route” and enter point A as 236 Merrimac Street, Merrimac, WI and point B as 12497 Wisconsin 188, WI. You can also save the route.

5. Alerts can also be set up on this page. Simply select “create an alert” and enter the pertinent information, such as:
 - a. “Closure” under Events;
 - b. “Select all” for Notification Type(s); and
 - c. Choose which days of the week to receive the notifications.
