




# **Temporary Traffic Control**

- Continue to examine existing guidance for design & planning as a group to evaluate the current recommendations for alternate work zone durations.
- Continue to discuss project successes for implementing Get In, Get Out
  - Reviewed the SE Region report for the 54-hr closure on IH-894 from 2024
- Continue to discuss proposed parameters when should this NOT be considered, i.e. rural applications, limited alternate routes, alternates leading to congestion elsewhere
- Considering developing stakeholder outreach criteria and/or best practices
- Considering adding a milestone prior to 60% in the FDM as a check for applicability due to likely changes from 30% to 60%
- Continue to meet on a monthly basis and develop a decision matrix based on project scope
- Identify and suggest pilot projects for implementation




