If you do send it to an individual and that person is not available, you may have to void and start over. See <u>instructions</u> (page 8; #16): "Verify the email address for the Central Office Mailbox is under email and Statewide Utility Projects Coordinator is under name for Order 2 of Recipients and Routing."
