Special Provisions

35. DELETED

45. Notice to Contractor, Hazardous Materials Soil Boring Coordination.

The department's environmental consultant will be conducting soil borings within the temporary limited easement at the southeast corner of the W. Lincoln Avenue/S. 84th Street intersection during construction. Coordinate with the environmental consultant to arrange an acceptable time for the borings to be completed. Clearly mark the temporary limited easement boundaries prior to the consultant arriving on site. Notify the engineer at least 10 business days prior to the southeast corner of the intersection becoming available for use. The environmental consultant is as follows:

46. Field Facilities Office Space, Item SPV.0060.17.

A Description

This special provision describes furnishing, equipping, and maintaining a field office as required in the contract at engineer-approved locations conforming to standard spec 642 and as follows.

B Materials

Provide Field Facilities Office Space conforming to standard spec 642.2.1 except delete paragraphs (1), (7), and (9).

Replace standard spec 642.2.1(4) with the following:

Provide and maintain suitable interior sanitary facilities conforming to State and local health requirements, in clean and good working condition, and stock with sanitary supplies for the duration of the contract. Furnish office space in an existing office building or existing building converted to office space with a minimum of 600 square feet. The facility shall have no fee parking with a minimum parking for 10 cars. The space shall include a meeting room with a minimum of 150 square feet. The exterior door(s) shall have locks in good working order and keys provided for all field staff. The office space shall be located within 2 miles of the construction project.

Equip the office as specified in standard spec 642.2.2.1 except delete paragraph (1) and (4) and add the following:

- 1. 3 suitable office desks with drawers and locks.
- 2. 3 ergonomically correct office chairs in working condition with at a minimum: 5-legged base with casters, seat adjustable from 15 to 22 inches from the floor with a seamless waterfall, rounded, front edge, and high backrest with no arms or adjustable arms.
- 3. 4 six-foot folding tables.
- 4. 1 ten-foot folding table.
- 5. 3 two-drawer file cabinets.

- 6. 3 four-shelf bookcases.
- 7. 10 folding chairs.

Provide for the professional cleaning of the field office during regular business hours twice monthly. Provide clearly marked recycling and waste receptacles within the field office, and separate recycling and waste dumpsters near the field office. Cover outdoor containers to keep out rain, snow, and wind-driven debris. Provide regularly scheduled recycling and waste pick-up.

C Construction

Conform to standard spec 642.3 except delete paragraph (2).

D Measurement

The department will measure the Field Facilities Office Space as each office acceptably completed.

E Payment

The department will pay for measured quantities at the contract unit price under the following bid item:

Payment is full compensation for providing, equipping, securing, and maintaining the facility; for parking, for telecommunications equipment, installation, and service fees; and for providing bottled water, utilities, fuel, ventilation, and toilet facilities as required, either independently or jointly with the field laboratory, for the time specified in 642.3.

The department will pay for the cost of telecommunications usage fees incurred by department staff.

47. Marking Grooved Preformed Thermoplastic Arrows Type 2, Item SPV.0060.15; Marking Grooved Preformed Thermoplastic Stop Line 18-Inch, Item SPV.0090.03; Marking Grooved Preformed Thermoplastic Crosswalk Block Style 24-Inch, Item SPV.0090.04; Marking Diagonal Grooved Preformed Thermoplastic 12-Inch, Item SPV.0090.05.

A Description

This special provision describes furnishing, grooving and installing preformed thermoplastic pavement markings as shown on the plans, according to standard spec 646, and as hereinafter provided.

B Materials

Furnish preformed thermoplastic pavement markings per manufacturer's recommendations and that meet the approval of the engineer. Marking materials shall be free of volatile organic compounds.

Furnish a copy of the manufacturer's specifications and recommendations to the engineer before preparing the pavement marking grooves.

C Construction

C.1 General

For quality assurance, provide the engineer evidence of manufacturer training in the proper placement and installation of preformed thermoplastic pavement marking.

Plane the grooved areas per manufacturer's recommendations. Use grooving equipment with a free-floating, independent cutting head. Plane a minimum number of passes to create a grooved surface.

C.2 Grooving

Replace standard spec 646.3.2.3.1(1) and (2) with the following:

(1) Cut the groove to a depth of 120 mils ± 10 mils from the pavement surface or, if tined, from the high point of the tined surface. To measure the depth, the contractor may use a depth plate placed in the groove and a straightedge placed across the plate and groove, or the contractor may use a straightedge placed perpendicular to the groove. The department may periodically check groove depths.

(2) Groove between 0 and 4 inches wider than the perimeter of the pavement marking. Achieve straight alignment with the grooving equipment, not to exceed 3/8 inch variation in any 40-foot length of marking. Use a high-pressure air blower to clean the groove.

C.3 Marking Application

Prepare the pavement surface and apply the pavement markings per manufacturer specifications.

Apply the pavement markings when the ambient temperature is above 32 degrees F. Prior to placing the markings, heat the pavement surface to at least 300 degrees F within the targeted area of the marking and at least 3 inches beyond the perimeter of the marking.

D Measurement

The department will measure Marking Grooved Preformed Thermoplastic by the unit, acceptably placed, or in length by the linear foot of line, placed according to the contract and accepted.

E Payment

The department will pay for measured quantities at the contract unit price under the following bid items:

Payment is full compensation for cleaning and preparing the pavement surface; furnishing and installing the material; and for removing existing or temporary pavement markings located within the limits of the grooved in permanent markings, if necessary.
