**3. Prosecution and Progress.**

*Add the following:*

**Westgate Community Sign**

This sign is located in the W Court Street median west of USH 51. The horizontal metal sign will be removed by others. The south brick column is to remain in place and shall not be disturbed. The north brick column and its foundation are to be removed under the Removing Masonry item. Prior to removals, salvage the concrete cap on the north column and place it outside the work zone for pickup by the Westgate community. Contact Jim Damrow at (262) 755-8424 when the cap is ready for pickup.

**A. Description**

Contractor must officially request a railroad flagger a minimum of 15 days prior to scheduled work. If the contractor fails to do so and is required to pay an Expedited Fee, the project will not reimburse the contractor for said fee.

### **Cable Locate Contact**

In addition to contacting Diggers Hotline, contact the Construction Contact at least five working days before the locate is needed. Reference the Crossing ID, Wisconsin Milepost and Subdivision found in A.1.

WSOR will only locate railroad owned facilities located in the railroad right-of-way. The railroad does not locate any other utilities.

### **A.4 Work by Railroad**

### **Flagging Contact**

See Construction Contact. If more than 30 days of flagging is required contact UP 40 days prior to needing a flagger on site. Reference the Wisconsin Milepost and Subdivision located in A.1.

### **Cable Locate Contact**

In addition to contacting Diggers Hotline, contact the UP Call Before You Dig line at (800) 336-9193 at least five working days before the locate is needed. Normal business hours are 6:30 AM to 6:30 PM, Central Time, Monday through Friday, except holidays and are subject to change. Calls will be routed at all times in case of an emergency. Reference the Wisconsin Milepost and Subdivision located in A.1.

UP will only locate railroad owned cable buried in the railroad right-of-way. The railroad does not locate any other utilities.

## **A.4 Work by Railroad**

The railroad will perform the work described in this section, except for work described in other special provisions, and will be accomplished without cost to the contractor: Replacing the crossing surface.

## **A.5 Temporary Grade Crossing**

If a temporary grade crossing is desired, submit a written request to the railroad representative named in A.3 at least 40 days prior to the time needed. Approval is subject to the discretion of the railroad. The department has made no arrangements for a temporary grade crossing.

## **A.6 Rail Security Awareness and Contractor Orientation**

Prior to entry on railroad right-of-way, the contractor shall arrange for on-line security awareness and contractor orientation training and testing and be registered through "e-RAILSAFE" for all contractor and subcontractor employees working on railroad right-of-way. See [e-railsafe.com](http://e-railsafe.com) "Information". The security awareness and contractor orientation training are shown under the railroad's name.

The security awareness and contractor orientation certification is valid for 2 year(s) and must be renewed for projects that will carry over beyond the 2 year period. Contractor and subcontractor employees shall wear the identification badge issued by e-RAILSAFE when on railroad right-of-way. Costs associated with training and registration are incidental to other items in the contract.

## **A.7 Contractor Right of Entry**

The contractor will be required to obtain a Right of Entry from Union Pacific Railroad prior to working on railroad right of way. Contact the person in A.1 Railroad Insurance Requirements at least 45 days prior to start of work. **The Right of Entry will be issued at no cost to the contractor. If the contractor pays for the Right of Entry, it will not be reimbursed by the project.** The Project ID will serve as the ROE permit number unless otherwise stated. Reference A.1 Railroad Insurance Requirements for railroad protective

liability insurance requirements. The required insurance is modified per the attached Contractor Right of Entry (CROE).

### **A.8 Flagging and Construction Observation**

Union Pacific Railroad requires that RailPros be utilized for flagging and construction observation for work within 25' of track centerlines. Contact RailPros prior to construction to coordinate administrative paperwork, flagger and observer scheduling, and work plans. RailPros contacts are as follows:

Reference the following project numbers when coordinating with RailPros. Note that it can take up to 45 days to satisfy all Union Pacific Railroad administrative construction observation requirements.

- 0795841: Real estate agreement between Union Pacific Railroad and the City of Janesville for water main. As of January 7, 2025 this agreement has been approved by Union Pacific Railroad but is pending signatures from the City of Janesville. It is anticipated that the fully executed agreement will be received in mid-February 2025.
- 0797847: Fully executed real estate agreement between Union Pacific Railroad and the City of Janesville for traffic signal conduit.
- 0796100: Pending real estate agreement between Union Pacific Railroad and the City of Janesville for storm sewer. As of January 7, 2025 this agreement has not yet been approved. However, it is anticipated that RailPros will be the required flagger and construction observer.
